  - 5. DOCUMENT, RECORD AND DISSEMINATE BEST PRACTICES AND MODEL STRATEGIES ACROSS THE REGION**
  - 6. COLLABORATE ACROSS COMMUNITIES, CROSS-BORDER COLLABORATION ON ADVOCACY/AWARENESS RAISING**
  - 7. DEVELOP A RESEARCH AGENDA ON WOMEN, PEACE AND SECURITY**
